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1. INTRODUCTION

Welcome to QoreChain. QoreChain Association ("QoreChain," "we," "us," or "our") is committed to protecting your privacy and ensuring transparency in how we collect, use, and safeguard your personal information.

This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and protect your information when you access or use:

- Our website at qorechain.io and dashboard.qorechain.io (the "Website")
- Our blockchain network and associated services (the "Network")
- Our AI-powered development tools including Smart Contract Generator and Auditor (the "AI Tools")
- Any related services, features, or functionalities (collectively, the "Services")

By accessing or using our Services, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to be bound by this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree with this Privacy Policy, please do not use our Services.

Important Note on Blockchain Technology: The QoreChain Network operates on distributed ledger technology. Certain information recorded on the blockchain is permanent, immutable, and publicly accessible by design. This Privacy Policy explains the distinction between traditional data we control and blockchain data that cannot be altered or deleted.

2. AGE RESTRICTIONS AND ELIGIBILITY

You must be at least 18 years of age (or the age of majority in your jurisdiction, whichever is higher) to use our Services. We do not knowingly collect or solicit personal information from anyone under the applicable age of majority. If you are under 18 (or the applicable age of majority), please do not attempt to register for the Services or send any personal information about yourself to us.

If we learn that we have collected personal information from a person under the applicable age of majority, we will delete that information as quickly as possible. If you believe that we might have any information from or about a person under the applicable age of majority, please contact us at team@qorechain.io.

4.1 Primary Uses

We use your information for the following purposes:

- Provide AI-powered development tools functionality
- Link wallet addresses to your user profile for seamless interaction
- Enable cross-chain operations and interoperability features

AI Model Training and Improvement

- Analyze prompts and inputs submitted to AI Tools (logged but not permanently stored)
- Train and improve our AI Smart Contract Generator and Auditor models
- Develop new AI features and capabilities
- Enhance natural language processing accuracy
- Improve code generation and security audit quality

Platform Improvement and Analytics

- Monitor and analyze usage patterns and trends
- Conduct product research and development
- Test new features and improvements (A/B testing)
- Optimize network performance and scalability
- Debug technical issues and improve system reliability

Communication and Support

- Respond to your inquiries and support requests
- Send transactional emails (account notifications, security alerts)
- Provide technical assistance and troubleshooting
- Send service announcements and updates

Marketing and Promotional Activities

- Send newsletters about QoreChain developments
- Deliver product updates and new feature announcements
- Share promotional offers and incentives
- Conduct market research and surveys
- Personalize marketing content based on your interests and usage

Security and Fraud Prevention

4.2 Legal Bases for Processing (GDPR)

For users in the European Economic Area (EEA), United Kingdom, and Switzerland, we process your personal data based on the following legal grounds:

- **Contractual Necessity:** Processing necessary to provide the Services you've requested
- **Legitimate Interests:** Fraud prevention, security, analytics, and product improvement (where not overridden by your rights)
- **Consent:** Marketing communications, non-essential cookies, and AI model training (where required)
- **Legal Obligation:** Compliance with laws, regulations, and legal processes

5. HOW WE SHARE YOUR INFORMATION

We do not sell, rent, or trade your personal information to third parties for their marketing purposes. We share your information only in the following circumstances:

5.1 Service Providers and Partners

We engage trusted third-party service providers to perform functions on our behalf:

Analytics and Performance

- Google Analytics (Google LLC) - Website and user behavior analytics
- Amplitude (Amplitude, Inc.) - Product analytics and usage patterns
- AWS (Amazon Web Services) - Cloud infrastructure and hosting

Authentication and Security

- Google OAuth (Google LLC) - User authentication and identity verification
- Security and fraud detection services

Communication Services

- Email service providers for transactional and marketing emails

- Customer support platforms

These service providers have access to your personal information only to perform specific tasks on our behalf and are obligated to protect your information and use it only for the purposes we specify.

5.2 Blockchain Network Participants

By design, certain information is shared with the QoreChain Network:

Public Blockchain Data (Permanently recorded and publicly accessible):

- Wallet addresses involved in transactions
- Transaction amounts, timestamps, and hashes
- Smart contract deployments and interactions
- Token transfers and balances
- Validator and staking activities

Network Participants:

- Validators and node operators who process transactions
- Other network users who query blockchain data
- Blockchain explorers and indexing services
- Cross-chain bridge protocols and connected networks

Important: This blockchain data is pseudonymous but NOT anonymous. While your real-world identity is not directly recorded, blockchain analytics firms and sophisticated actors may be able to correlate wallet addresses with identities through various means.

5.3 Business Transfers

In the event of a merger, acquisition, financing, reorganization, bankruptcy, or sale of assets, your information may be transferred as part of that transaction. We will notify you via email and/or prominent notice on our Website of any change in ownership or use of your personal information.

5.4 Legal Requirements and Protection

We may disclose your information when we believe in good faith that disclosure is necessary to:

- Comply with applicable laws, regulations, legal processes, or governmental requests
- Enforce our Terms of Service, policies, or other agreements
- Protect the security, rights, or property of QoreChain, our users, or the public
- Detect, prevent, or address fraud, security, or technical issues
- Respond to claims of violations of the rights of third parties

5.5 With Your Consent

We may share your information for purposes not described in this Privacy Policy when we have your explicit consent to do so.

6. INTERNATIONAL DATA TRANSFERS

QoreChain is based in Switzerland, and our Services are accessible globally. We process and store information in Switzerland, the United States, and other jurisdictions where our service providers operate, including the European Union, Asia, Turkey, and Latin America.

6.1 Transfer Mechanisms

When we transfer personal data from the EEA, UK, or Switzerland to other countries, we implement appropriate safeguards, including:

EU-U.S. Data Privacy Framework (where applicable)

- Compliance with Privacy Shield principles for U.S. transfers

Standard Contractual Clauses (SCCs)

- European Commission-approved model contracts with service providers
- Supplementary measures where required to ensure adequate protection

7. DATA RETENTION

7.1 Traditional Data Retention

Active Accounts

- Account information: Retained while your account is active

- Usage data and logs: Typically retained for 12-24 months for analytics and security purposes
- AI tool inputs: Logged for training purposes, then deleted within 90 days
- Marketing preferences: Retained until you unsubscribe or delete your account

Deleted Accounts

- Upon account deletion, we delete or anonymize your personal information within 30 days
- Certain information may be retained longer if required by law or legitimate business purposes (e.g., fraud prevention, legal compliance)
- Aggregated, anonymized data may be retained indefinitely for analytics

Legal and Security Retention

- Information related to legal disputes or investigations: Retained as necessary
- Security incident logs: Retained for up to 7 years
- Financial records: Retained as required by applicable law (typically 7-10 years)

7.2 Blockchain Data Retention

Immutable Data

- Blockchain transactions, smart contracts, and associated data are permanent and immutable by design
- This information CANNOT be deleted, modified, or anonymized once recorded on the blockchain
- Even after account deletion, your blockchain wallet addresses and transaction history remain publicly accessible

What This Means:

- Consider carefully before executing blockchain transactions
- Use separate wallets for privacy-sensitive activities
- Blockchain data exists independently of your QoreChain account
- We cannot comply with deletion requests for blockchain-recorded data

8. YOUR PRIVACY RIGHTS

Your rights vary depending on your location. We respect and facilitate the exercise of your privacy rights under applicable laws.

8.1 Rights for All Users

- **Access:** Request access to the personal information we hold about you
- **Correction:** Request correction of inaccurate or incomplete information
- **Deletion:** Request deletion of your account and personal information (subject to blockchain limitations)

- Secure cloud infrastructure (AWS)
- Regular security audits and penetration testing
- DDoS protection and rate limiting
- Intrusion detection and prevention systems

9.2 Organizational Safeguards

Policies and Training

- Employee confidentiality agreements
- Regular security awareness training
- Data protection impact assessments (DPIAs)
- Incident response and breach notification procedures

Vendor Management

9.3 Limitations

- We are not responsible for losses due to user error or wallet compromise

9.4 Data Breach Notification

In the event of a data breach that affects your personal information, we will:

- Notify affected users without undue delay (within 72 hours where required by GDPR)
- Report to relevant supervisory authorities as required by law
- Provide information about the breach and steps we're taking to address it
- Advise you on protective measures you can take

11.1 AI Tool Usage

Our AI Smart Contract Generator and Auditor use machine learning models to:

- Generate smart contract code based on natural language prompts
- Analyze smart contracts for security vulnerabilities and optimization opportunities
- Provide development suggestions and best practices

How Your Input Is Used:

- Prompts and queries are logged (not permanently stored) for quality assurance
- Inputs are used to train and improve our AI models
- Data is aggregated and anonymized before training
- Individual inputs are deleted within 90 days

Your Control:

- Opting out may limit functionality of AI Tools

11.2 Automated Decision-Making

We do not use automated decision-making that produces legal or similarly significant effects without human oversight. AI-generated outputs (such as smart contracts) are recommendations only; you maintain full control over implementation decisions.

For EEA/UK/Swiss users: You have the right not to be subject to decisions based solely on automated processing. Contact us if you have concerns about automated decision-making.

12. DO NOT TRACK SIGNALS

Some browsers include a "Do Not Track" (DNT) feature that signals to websites that you do not want your online activities tracked. Due to lack of industry consensus on DNT interpretation, our Services do not currently respond to DNT signals.

However, you can control tracking through:

Processing: Any operation performed on personal data, including collection, storage, use, disclosure, or deletion.

Controller: The entity that determines the purposes and means of processing personal data (QoreChain Association).

Processor: An entity that processes personal data on behalf of the controller (our service providers).

Pseudonymization: Processing that renders personal data non-identifiable without additional information kept separately.

Wallet Address: A unique alphanumeric identifier on a blockchain that can send and receive transactions.

Smart Contract: Self-executing code deployed on a blockchain that automatically enforces agreement terms.

Gas Fees: Transaction fees paid to process operations on a blockchain network.
